Pursuant to the New HR methodology for induction of Agniveerveyu under 'Agnipath Scheme', aimed to provide an opportunity to Nation's youth to experience military way of life for a period of four years. <u>Indian Air Porce invites ONLNE application from unmarried Indian male and female candidates for selection test from 13 October 2023 onwards to Join the IAF as an AGNIVEERVAYU.</u> The number and employability of female candidates will be decided as per service requirement.

(THE SELECTION TEST IS NOT FOR SELECTION AS COMMISSIONED OFFICERS/ PILOTS/ NAVIGATORS)

- Application is required to be filled only ONLINE by the candidates and detailed instructions to fill up the same are at at https://applicatthways.cdec.in.
- 3. This examination is valid for AGNIVEERVAYU INTAKE 01/2024.

#### ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- (a) Date of Birth Block. Candidate born between 27 June 2003 and 27 December 2006 (both dates inclusive) are eligible to apply.
- (b) In case, a candidate clears all the stages of the Selection Procedure, then the upper age limit as on date of enrol 21 years.
- Marital Status and Pregnancy. Only unmarried candidates (male & female) will be eligible for enrolment as Agniveervayu and they shall ritake not to many during the defined engagement period of four years. Keeping in view limited period of engagement of Agniveervayu inclusive of ing, skill development activities, practical as well as formative assessment and organisational requirement of continued service of Agniveervayu during the engagement period will adversely affect for operational efficiency of the Indian croze. Agniveervayu who many during the said period shall be discharged from the service. Further, only unmarried Agniveervayu will be eligible for fortion in regular carder as Airman. Fermals candidates additionally shall be required to undertake not to get pregnant during the engagement period, in women Agniveervayu on becoming Low Medicall Category (LMC) due to pregnancy shall be liable to be discharged from service. - Mandatory Medical Standards. General Medical Standards for AGNIVEERVAYU male & female candidates are as follows:-

  - Note: Candidates should bring prescription and spectacles for corrected vision, if used. The latest prescription should contain diopter measurement, Ophthalmologist's registration number, stamp, signature and date of prescription should be within a month prior to appearing
- General Health: Candidate should be of normal anatomy without loss of any appendages. He / She should be free from any active or acute or chronic, medicin or surgicul disability or communicatible disease, inflection and skin aitments. Candidate shall be physically and yFIT to perform (utylin any part of the world, in any climate and terrain.

# TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- 12. Agriveenayu will be enrolled in the Indian Air Force under Air Force Act 1950, for a period of FOUR years. Agriveenayu would form a distinct rank in the Indian Air Force, different from any other existing ranks. The Indian Air Force is not obliged to retain Agriveenayu beyond the enagement prior of four years.
- 13. On completion of four years of service, based on organisation's requirements and policies promalgated by the Indian Air Force, Agniveorusys will be offered an opportunity to apply for enrolment in the regular cader of the Indian Air Force as Airmen. These applications will be considered in a centralised manner based on objective criteria, including performance during their lour-year engagement period and up to 25% of each specific batch of Agniveorusys will be seroided in regular cade of U.F. Agniveorusys will not have any right to be selected for further enrolment into the Indian Air Force. Selection of the Agniveorusys for further enrolment, if any, shall be at the discretion of the Government of India.
- Employability. Agniveervayu enrolled under this entry are liable to be assigned any duty in organisational interest at the dis Indian Air Force.
- 15. Training. On being enrolled, Agniveervayu will be imparted military training besed on Indian Air Force requ
- Leave. Grant of leave will be subject to exigencies of the Indian Air Force. The following leave is applicable for Agriv

In addition, Risk and Hardship allowances (as applicable in IAP), Pross and Travel allowances will be paid, uch as ration, colling, accommodation and Leaver Travel Concession (ICT) shall also be provided as per the existing rules.

- Candidates declared medically unfit can avail the option for 'Appeal Medical Board' (AMB) against their unfitness by depositing Rs. 40/- in a Government Treasury/RB/SBI through Electronic Military Receivable Order (e-MRO) / Military Receivable Order (MRO). The application for AMB along with original copy of e-MRO / MRO, photocopy of Unfitness Certificate are to be submitted to the representative of ASC within three working days of medical examination.

- 34. The recruitment medical officer and the specialist doctors of Armad Forces are the final authorities on declaring a candidate fit or unfit during initial medical examination, appeal medical board and medical examination prior to enrolment. The candidates shall be governed by Armad Forces standards which may be at variance from civil standards. There is no provision for representation or review after the appeal medical board.
